Re: Area Green Space Plan - Brislington East and West

I am writing to invite you to the second and third sessions of the participation process to inform a draft of the Brislington Area Green Space Plan. The next session will on **Thursday 17th July** and the following session on **Thursday 24th July**. Both of these sessions will be held at **Wicklea Youth and Community Centre**, Wick Road, Brislington and begin at **7-00pm**.

Both of these sessions will consider the spatial aspect of the Area Green Space Plans - what types of space and major facilities Brislington should have and where. This will include the following:

- The council will present what the green space standards adopted in the Parks and Green Space Strategy are saying for children's playgrounds, formal green space, facilities for young people, natural green space and informal green space;
- We will discuss the above and the role and character that Brislington's spaces have or could be;
- We will discuss the identification of 'low value' green space that may be considered for alternative use or to sell in order to raise funds to make improvements;
- We will discuss who else needs to be involved in these sessions.

In addition, at the next meeting on the 17th July I will respond to the themes and questions raised at our first session and we will set a longer term agenda based on these with future meeting dates.
